Advice received at the recent EALC Audit Briefing that the assets of Parish Councils can depreciate or not depreciate so long as rules are applied consistently. Previously the value was taken from the insurance schedule for the goal posts and lamp posts. Clir. David Potter proposed and Clir. James Bunn seconded that the goal posts, dog bins and party tents should depreciate at 20% per year over 5 years and the gates should depreciate at 10% per year over 10 years. The lamp post value will continue to be taken from the insurance schedule. The value of Bell Meadow should remain at the current level. All councillors present agreed.
