- Parking – acknowledged that this is something to think about. Although no solutions come to mind. It is expected that there will not be huge numbers visiting the playground at the same time (it is likely to be an intermittent problem) and people park in the road/layby opposite The Bell now anyway. Local people are encouraged to walk.
- Maintenance vs Annual Inspection. Further research required into this.
- School Fete – if the project moves forward fast enough a leaflet could be distributed with information about crowd funding.
- Bell Meadow Day – opportunity to display some of the proposals. If the project has moved forward enough could promote funding etc.
- Fundraiser – suggestions included an event at the Village Hall or Bell Meadow. Also an event for Children.
- £25k was agreed to be the target budget.
- Lisa & Jacky to go back to playground companies and ask them to revise their quotes to fit into the budget.
