The average family in the UK wastes £720 worth of food every year – that's around £60 per month.

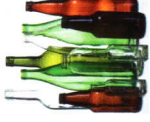

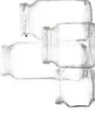
RECYCLING BOX FOR GLASS

Glass jars (no food residue)

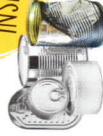
Did you know

PINK RECYCLING SACKS

FOR RECYCLING ONLY (Clean and dry)

LIDS INSIDE



Food tins & cans



Foil & foil trays



Empty aerosols (LEAVE LIDS ON)



Paper, card & junk mail



Food and drinks cartons



Plastic tubs, trays & pots



Plastic bottles (LEAVE LIDS ON)

Did you know
Where possible present cardboard inside your pink sack to keep it dry. Small amounts of empty cardboard boxes will be collected if they are all flattened and presented beside your pink sacks.

NO THANKS: Food, glass, nappies, wet wipes, hard plastic, polystyrene, food bags and wrapping, wallpaper, takeaway cups, clothes, tissues, kitchen roll, PPE (disposable gloves, face masks)

GREY WHEELED BIN

FOR HOUSEHOLD WASTE (That cannot be recycled or composted)

Hard plastics
