ACMD Nitrous Oxide: public call for evidence1

Home Office (08/02/23)

The Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs (ACMD) Nitrous Oxide working group has issued a call for evidence to help in their formulation of advice to government. The deadline to submit written feedback is Tuesday 21 February 2023.

Extra funding for drug and alcohol treatment: 2023 to 20254

Office for Health Improvement & Disparities (16/02/23)

This information provides a breakdown of the extra funding available to all local authorities in England for the financial year 2023 to 2024 and an indicative allocation for 2024 to 2025. The funding will help them improve their drug and alcohol treatment and recovery systems.

Domestic abusers face crackdown in raft of new measures<sup>5</sup>

Home Office (20/02/23)

The law will be changed so that the most dangerous domestic abusers will be watched more closely. Controlling or coercive behaviour will be put on a par with physical violence, which will mean offenders sentenced to a year or more imprisonment or a suspended sentence will automatically be actively managed by the police, prison and probation services under multi-agency public protection arrangements. A range of agencies will have a legal duty to cooperate to manage the risks posed by these dangerous offenders.

Thematic inspection report on the experiences of black and mixed heritage boys in the youth justice system<sup>6</sup>



Office for Health Improvement & Disparities (02/02/23)

Alcohol and drug treatment data for young people under 18, from the National Drug Treatment Monitoring System (NDTMS).

Focuses on incidents and fires attended by fire and rescue services, fire-related fatalities, casualties from those fires and response times to those fires.
