LITTLE YELDHAM, TILBURY JUXTA CLARE AND OVINGTON PARISH COUNCIL CELEBRATES



Little Yeldham, Tilbury Juxta Clare and Ovington Parish Council are celebrating after being awarded £58,000 in funding from The National Lottery Community Fund, the largest funder of community activity in the UK.

They will use their funding to refurbish the Little Yeldham Village Recreation Ground where presently there are just two pieces of play equipment. This funding, together with funding from the Bruce Wake Trust, the East of England Co-op, generous donations from supporters and village fundraising will allow them to not only introduce new equipment but improve access making the area accessible to all irrespective of age and ability. The Parish Council are still arranging events to fundraise for maintenance and future improvements and their next event is a Spring Fayre in the Village Hall on Saturday 25th March 2023 when they hope to have more details about a start date for this exciting project. REMINDER: ESSEX RECYCLING CENTRE BOOKING SYSTEM ANNOUNCED



From Monday 13th March 2023, residents visiting Essex County Council (ECC) recycling centres will need to book in advance.

A booking system will be trialled for all vehicles visiting ECC recycling centres to help manage waiting times, reduce congestion, and improve the customer experience.

The booking process has already been trialled for all vehicles using Rayleigh Recycling Centre, and also for large vehicles using the nine van-friendly sites. Both trials have been effective in smoothing the pattern of demand across operating hours and reducing queues and congestion both in and around the sites.
